Parent Governor Vacancies

As a result of two parent governor terms of office coming to an end, the Governing Body now has two vacancies for Parent Governors. All parents (including carers) of registered pupils at the school are eligible to stand for election. Should there be more nominations than vacancies to fill, a secret ballot will take place. The term of office for Parent Governors will be as per the Instrument of Government for this school, which is four years. Parents have an important role to play in the education of children and being a Parent Governor can give you an opportunity to contribute to the education of all children at your school. Training and support for Parent Governors is provided by both the school and the Local Authority. Parents who wish to be nominated should request a nomination form from the office, which they should read carefully and complete.
